

## BEGINNING CHINESE





The Confucius Institute at Arizona State University offers Beginning Chinese and Individual Tutoring in Chinese. These courses are designed for individuals to gain a basic knowledge of Mandarin

## CHINESE 1A

Chinese 1A is designed for people who have successfully completed the beginning Chinese I course. This course lays emphasis on improving the ability of the student to use Chinese for communication. By the end of this second course, students will be able to successfully engage in simple daily conversation such as how to check in at a hotel, how to pick up friends at the airport, and have a conversation at dinner or on a business trip. In addition, Chinese cultural elements are taught to supplement the course and impart the knowledge necessary to navigate within the Chinese culture.
