ABOUT

Students will have the opportunity to demonstrate their ability in the target language by competing with other students of the same level from different high schools at the ASU World Language Fair. There will be judges present for each competition, and trophy and certificates for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place winners will be awarded. Each student **MUST** pre-registers to participate in the competition. Registration will begin in January 2016. Description of Level are as follows, use of PowerPoints/poster/hands on tools are allowed:

Novice Mid: *Each school can register no more than 3 groups for this level.*

Students will compete in prepared presentation/conversation/role play etc. on the topic **"My Favorite Food."** Presentation will be evaluated on language assuredness/fluency, pronunciation, feeling and memorization.

Novice High: *Each school can register no more than 3 students for this level.*

Students will compete in prepared presentation on the topic **"My Favorite Festival Food."** Students may compare the Chinese Festival with a Western Festival. Presentation will be evaluated on language assuredness/fluency, pronunciation, grammar and vocabulary usage, feeling and memorization. The presentation can be about, but is not limited to, the following festival food: Spring Festival, Lantern Festival, Dragon Boat Festival, Mid-Autumn Festival, etc.

Intermediate: Chinese food can be roughly divided into eight regional cuisines. Students can select one of the cuisines to introduce and explain its significance. The presentation will be evaluated on language assuredness/fluency, pronunciation, grammar and vocabulary usage, feeling and preparedness. Presentation can be about, but is not limited to, the following regional cuisines: Shandong, Sichuan, Canton, Fujian, Jiangsu, Zhejiang, Hunan, Anhui, etc.
